

The Lodge membership data migration is now complete, and you now have access to the new system. It is important for you to log in ASAP, review your profile, make changes to your contact data, and upload a current picture for your new permanent ID card.



All of the students touched the theraputty which surprised me. Most of the time they are hesitant to try new things but when they saw how fun the theraputty looked, they were excited to try.

My next step in my classroom is to just add to my sensory area. I just want to make sure all of my students have a safe place to go and take a break when they need it. Dear South Seminole Masonic Lodge #364,


